- Goalball is a Paralympic sport exclusive to athletes with visual impairments, played by both men and women.
- Goalball is played in a gym. The objective of the game is to throw the ball using a bowling motion into the opponent's net while the opposing players try to block the ball with their bodies.
- Goalball is played on a court with tactile markings to help orientate the players to their location on the court. The ball also has noise bells which help players track the direction of the ball.
